## Overview

This innovative course is designed to meet the Washington State requirements for continuing education for school counselors (ESA: Peer Review Course). School counselors from across the state will have an opportunity to share their successes and concerns, as well as support one another's professional development.

The Department of Educational Leadership and Counseling Psychology, in collaboration with Washington State University's Center for Distance and Professional Education, offers CoPsy 561 online. The course is taught in an asynchronous format, allowing maximum flexibility and 24/7 access.

## Online Course CoPsy 561

- provide opportunities to exchange knowledge about specific school counseling techniques and relevant resources.
- provide opportunities to build and exchange knowledge about current developments in the field of school counseling including the ASCA National Model, the work of the Education Trust, and national certification through the National Board for Professional Teaching Standards.
