✍ All requirements for the teacher certificate must be completed within 5 years from the date of certification in the College of Education, otherwise the student must fulfill all new program requirements.

✍ A maximum of 3 semester hours of correspondence work will be allowed.

✍ Apply for the degree and the teacher certificate upon completion of 80 semester hours.

✍ Establish a placement file at Career Services during the junior year.
