- ✓ Students in the Honors College fulfill honors requirements in place of GERs (except Hist 150, Math 251 and 252, Mus 153, and science requirements).
  - ✓ 120 hours are required for the bachelor's degree.
  - ✓ For the BA degree a candidate must complete the course work listed plus additional electives or endorsement course work to equal or exceed 120 semester hours. Apply for the degree and the teacher certificate upon completion of 80 semester hours. Establish a placement file at Career Services during the junior year.
  - ✓ All course work for the Elementary Education degree, each endorsement, Math 251 & 252, ComSt 102, Engl composition, US History, Psych 198 or 105, and all science GER's must be taken for a letter grade (not pass/fail) and completed with a grade of C or higher. A student will not be placed to student teach or recommended for a teacher certificate if the endorsement or cum. WSU gpa is below 2.5. WSP and FBI fingerprinting and background clearance must also be on file at OSPI before student teaching may begin.
  - ✓ All requirements for the teacher certificate must be completed within 5 years from the date of certification in the College of Education; otherwise the student must fulfill all new program requirements.

<sup>1</sup> A score of 16 on the intermediate math placement test or SAT quantitative score of 500 is required for enrollment.

<sup>2</sup> Mus 153 must be taken as a prerequisite to Mus 388 if music proficiency is not established by examination.

<sup>3</sup> If Hist 198 is not US History then choose Hist 150 or AmSt 216.

<sup>4</sup> In addition to the University GER's, the Department of Teaching and Learning requires an additional science course [B,P,Q].

<sup>5</sup> SpEd 402 substitutes for EdPsy 401.

<sup>6</sup> Completion of the Writing Portfolio is required before students may take Block I.

<sup>7</sup> SpEd401 substitutes for T&L 310.

<sup>8</sup> SpEd 421is for those students in the special education endorsement. SpEd 301 substitutes for SpEd 420.
