The intern will perform the duties and responsibilities specified in a reliable and conscientious manner and will maintain regular contact with the university instructor and site supervisor, informing them of any problems which might develop in performing those duties.

The agency supervisor will assign duties consistent with intern readiness and provide the necessary supervision to perform those duties. The site supervisor will perform at least one hour per week of formal, scheduled, individual supervision. Additionally, at the end of the semester, the supervisor will also provide an evaluation of the intern's performance, using a form provided by the WSU instructor.

The WSU instructor will be available to both the intern and the agency to facilitate the fulfillment of this contract and to monitor and facilitate the intern's progress.
