Important Points

- 1. Even if you know a teacher, follow the chain of command check with the office first. (You may have to contact the school district office!)
- 2. Some schools may require some type of formal contact with WSU.
- 3. Be **totally** familiar with the info on the website. Some teachers will ask "what are you supposed to do while you are in my classroom?" Have an answer ready!

Journal
