BRIEF BIOGRAPHY

Dr. Yichien Cooper received her Ph. D. in Art Education from Florida State University with a Museum Studies Certificate. Her research interests focus on theories and practices of arts integration in relation to STEAM and design thinking, concept mapping, data visualization, social justice, arts-based and narrative inquiry, mixed identity, and cultural competence. She has given numerous keynotes and workshops internationally. Besides publishing in journals here and aboard, she has published Chinese textbooks to promote arts integrations. She authored Curriculum Design: On Thinking of Integrated Arts Curriculum (Hung-Yeh, 2016) and The Power of Integrated Curriculum: The Core of STEAM Education (Hunan Fine Art, 2017). She edited The 21st Century Arts and Culture Education (Hung-Yeh, 2018), co-edited with Dr. Solan Wong and Dr. Irene Hung on Challenges and Transformation: Conference E-Proceeding of 2018 InSEA Asia Reginal Conference & the 7th World Chinese Arts Education Symposium (2020), coedited with Ming-Tai Cheng on New Trends in World Art Education Research (Shanghai Education Press, 2020), co-translated Patricia Leavy's Method Meets Art with Wendy Hsieh (Hunan Fine Art, 2019). Her integrating arts approach has made waves in the field of art education in China, Malaysia, and Taiwan. These books received many adaptations from teacher education programs and universities. Her recent co-edited English book with Dr. Kevin Hsieh and Dr. Lilly Lu, Teaching Chinese Arts and Culture (InSEA Publication) aims to provide practical and unbiased teaching strategies for art teachers to embrace Chinese aesthetics and artistic skills. She serves as a manuscript reviewer for Journal of Social Theory in Art Education (JSTAE), Educational Studies, and International Journal of Cognitive Performance Support (IJCPS). She also reviews conference proposals for National Art Education Association, International Society of Education through Art, and World Chinese Art Education Association. As an avid arts advocate, she serves as a reviewer and advisor for Taiwan's cross-curriculum reform taskforce at National Academy for Educational Research (2014-2017) and the Chair of the Asian Arts and Culture Interests Group at National Art Education Association (2021-2023). She gave many workshops, keynotes, and seminars internationally. In 2019, she was a Visiting Professor at the Faculty of Fine Arts at Srinakharinwirot University and in 2020, she was an International Visiting Scholar, College of Fine Art, Henan University. She is the Honorary President (2021-) and the Past-President of the World Chinese Arts Education Association (2017-2021) and the Past-Chair of Data Visualization Working Group (2017-2021).
